Thank you so very much for volunteering to fill a Love Box! The filled Love Boxes are gifted to children in hospitals across the GTA, Durham, and up North.

Love Box Guidelines:

- Please do not include candy, food, or gum.
- Please only include new and unused items in the Love Boxes.
- Clothing is acceptable for Newborn Love Boxes only.
- New socks, slippers, and hats are welcomed for Love Boxes for all age groups.
- Please do not include razors or toy weapons for the safety and security reasons.

Examples of hygiene items you can include:

Small packages of Kleenex, diaper wipes, mouthwash, dental floss, toothbrushes, toothpaste, deodorant, combs/brushes, dry shampoo, facial wipes, lip balm, lotion, and hair accessories.

Examples of items you can include in the Love Boxes?

Newborn: Blankets, stuffed animals, clothing, teething, soothers, socks, bibs, small toys, books, and care items for the parents.

Children (Ages 2 to 12): Colouring books, pencil crayons etc., books, journals, craft sets, LEGO, decks of cards, small games, fidget toys, Play-Doh, stickers, activity books, soft sports balls, word search books, pens/pencils, cars, dolls, socks/slippers, hats, reusable water bottles/cups, Silly Putty, puzzles, nail polish, bubbles, small toys, action figures, stuffed animals,

Teen (Ages 13 to 18): Colouring books, pencil crayons, books, journals, decks of cards, small games, make-up, word search books, pens/pencils, socks/slippers, hats, fidget toys, Tech Decks, sketch books, LEGO, reusable water bottles/cups, Silly Putty, soft sports balls, puzzles, and nail polish, beanie boots, gift cards.
