Beloved in Christ,

By order of the Government of Ontario, **effective Friday, June 11, 2021** the Province of Ontario will move forward into Step 1 of its reopening Plan!

The following public health safety measures are applicable for all Places of Worship: *Indoor services, including weddings, baptisms, and funerals are permitted at 15 % capacity of the particular room.*

Please note that attendance will continue to be based on a **first-come, first-serve** basis. Once our capacity has been reached, further entry will not be permitted. Anyone arriving at this point will be asked to remain outside while maintaining 2 m of physical distance or in their vehicles where they will be able to follow to the Services via our live radio feed on **97.9 FM**.

Safety Measures:

1. **STAY HOME** if you have a cough, shortness of breath, or a fever.
2. **EVERYONE MUST** follow the instructions of our Leadership team (i.e. the Priest, Parish Council, Philoptochos) at all times.
3. Masks/face coverings are to be worn at all times **EXCEPT** for those who have a medical condition which precludes them from doing so.
4. Upon entry:
 - a. Use the touchless hand sanitizer provided at the entrance;
 - b. Your temperature will be taken by a Council Member;
 - c. Provide your name and contact information;
 - d. Light your candle;
 - e. Place your weekly offering in the basket provided; *It is preferable that you consider sending your weekly donations/tithing via eTransfer or PayPal.*
 - f. You will be directed to your seat; Remain in your seat at all times (unless using the facilities) and follow all prescribed safe practices;
 - g. Social Distancing and proper sanitization is mandatory.
5. The use of the basement is for **WORSHIP ONLY**. There is absolutely **NO SOCIALIZING** during the Services. Kindly respect those who wish to pray.
6. Curbside pick-up for our pre-order weekly meals will continue as usual.
7. Fellowship or socializing inside the Church is not permitted at this time.
8. Unless volunteering, **EVERYONE MUST** leave the Church immediately following the Services.
If you wish to volunteer to help clean the Church after a Service (which would be greatly appreciated), please speak to a member of the Parish Council and they will gladly assist you!
